For Such a Time as This

'A hill[billy] preacher told how the Lord took a handful of sand and made a man and hung him on the barbed wire fence to dry. "Then He took a handful of dust and made a woman the same way". "Preacher, where did that barbed wire fence come from?" "It's questions like that this is ruinin' religion"."

Well, it's attitudes like this that truly short-circuit our brains. We humans were given the blessings of creativity. We were given sentience, intelligence, emotions, rationality. An Oklahoma legislator has even introduced a bill to prohibit public schools from providing litter boxes for children to relieve themselves in, those "furries" who believe themselves to be cats, dogs, etc. Who would have ever dreamed that such madness would threaten to overtake America? But that is what happens when a society that once knew God exchanges the truth for lies. Rejecting truth results in all manner of lies and false identities. Rejecting God ultimately means we reject ourselves, and thus we become any kind of thing that we are not. Such people are under a spell, and prefer the spell to reality. How they need to be pitied and "woken up"! For these same people are the first to deify anything and everything that is not God, and kill and destroy anything else that reminds them of the Truth, most especially unborn baby humans. No wonder abortion is a sacred ritual to them!

As we hurtle toward the end of this age, in God's perfect timing, He is quickly revealing to us everything we need to know to not just survive, but thrive, during these increasingly dangerous and difficult end times. Why, now is it "imperfectly" formed, and void, "empty"? We see in verse 2 that the entire earth is covered with deep waters. These deep waters, when one thinks of them, remind us of a later time when, once again, the earth was totally covered by water: Noah's flood. In Noah's day, why was the world totally covered with water? For judgement. For cleansing. For purification. Then God declares to Noah in Genesis 9:11: "Yes, I am confirming My covenant with you. Never again will floodwaters kill all living creatures; never again will a flood destroy the earth". It sounds like this was not the first time. What if the state of the earth as we read it described in Genesis 1:2, indicates that the world was then being cleansed from evil and unrighteousness? Does this not make more sense?

Consider. We know that satan indwelt the serpent in Genesis 3. This flawed "heavenly" being was on earth, and was definitely not perfect! It was an evil being; indeed the very first evil being, the first to sin and the first to fall from heaven to the earth. We also know that this planet was created a very, very long time before Adam and Eve and the rest of today's wonderful flora and fauna were created. For Job 38:7 tells us that the heavenly beings rejoiced when they witnessed God creating the earth at the very beginning. God asked Job a series of questions, including "Who laid [the earth's] cornerstone ⁷as the morning stars sang to-

gether and all the angels shouted for joy?"

So the earth was once perfect, as were all the beings that God created long before Adam and Eve. But here in Genesis 1:2, the earth is covered with water to eliminate the infestation of evil, fallen life that had invaded it. God is now reforming, restoring, "remodeling" earth. Repairing, renewing and resurrecting its perfection, readying it for God's final created beings to inhabit and care for it, beings now made in His very image—humanity. And Adam and Eve lived on the earth, happily ever after. Unfortunately no. They fell from grace. So has America. And all humanity, starting with them. Noah was righteous, but not without sin. But God's plan was progressing. A mystery to all but Himself.

When Adam and Eve were created, they were perfect, sinless. The devil couldn't stand it. So, he attacked. Our hapless first parents, fell for his charms. God did not not see this coming. It was actually part of His glorious plan. But for all his "troubles", the devil was told he would not ever prevail; indeed, his very head would be crushed to death by the Offspring of this woman, Eve, the very one he had hoodwinked.
